

# sentence writing tips for compare and contrast essays

Are you facing difficulty in articulating your topic sentences for your essay? Do not worry! It is a common problem for most beginner students, so you are not an exception to it. However, make an effort to learn how you can better write a topic by sentencing your essay because topic sentences have a very important place in an essay.



Every essay is based on three components, an introduction, a body, and a concluding paragraph. Similarly, a compare and contrast essay includes all of them in it. Within an introduction, a thesis statement is provided that states the main claim of the essay, and body paragraphs further elaborate that thesis with evidence. A conclusion is the mirror image of the introduction of the essay as it states the same things in different words. Each body paragraph is a mini-essay in itself as it includes a topic sentence, supporting points, and a concluding sentence at the end. However, most of the students fail to write good topic sentences and thus, get low scores.

Moreover, this problem is pervasive in compare and contrast essays as the majority of the students do not provide well-written topic sentences in their essays and their essays become loose-ended, disorganized, and lack compactness and coherence. In a compare and contrast essay, the [essay writer](#) is required to compare and contrast the similarities and differences between two ideas, texts, events, or persons. The purpose of this essay is to help students develop critical thinking skills and reasoning. By assigning comparative essays, your professor wants to judge your analytical skills and your ability to analyze information bit by bit that others might miss report.

However, the majority of the students do not write a good compare and contrast essay mainly because they lack efficiency in writing and proper understanding of this kind of essay. For them, it is better to visit

However, writing cannot be improved overnight, it requires time and a lot of practice and reading. Writing a better essay requires expertise in writing and a sound knowledge base. Mostly, students who have a tendency to ask someone else, "[write my essay for me](#)," fail to develop their writing skills adequately as they never practice it themselves.

A compare and contrast essay can be structured either on the subject-by-subject method or the point-by-point method. Therefore, writing meaningful topic sentences and connected paragraphs is key to success in essay writing.

## Following are some tips to write a good topic sentence.

### 1- It must introduce an idea

Every topic sentence is a mini-thesis and it should introduce an idea or the main idea of the paragraph. Giving sweeping statements or generic ones will make them redundant and less appealing. So, make a claim in the topic sentence.

### 2- One idea in one sentence

In your topic sentence, discuss one idea at a time, and do not rush to include more than one idea in your topic sentence. If [write my paper](#) service provider introduces more than one idea in your topic sentence, it becomes overburdened and affects the structure of the paragraph.

### 3- Hit the topic directly

In your topic sentence, hit the topic directly and do not include supplementary sentences before it. Hitting the idea directly enables your reader to grasp the main idea of your paragraph and helps her navigate through the paragraph easily.

### 4- Connect it with previous paragraphs

This connection is very important in an essay. If paragraphs are not connected with each other they give your essay a look of patchwork. Using transitional words, and connectors can help you connect your paragraphs and make your essay coherent and compact.

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
