



However, some people who take oral steroids develop side-effects.. Low blood pressure (hypotension) which can cause dizziness, fainting or collapse. If the dose is reduced gradually, the body gradually resumes its natural production of steroids and the withdrawal.

The pharmacological treatment of choice for acute vestibular neuritis is oral steroids beginning as soon as possible with gradual tapering of the dose. One third of patients have chronic vestibular symptoms and develop benign paroxysmal positioning vertigo (BPPV). <u>secret info</u>



The oral steroid patients experienced typical symptoms, such as sleep, mood and appetite changes. Steroids are stored in the fat cells of your body so it can take some time for them to completely leave your body.
