

Steps for Writing Process Essay - 2022

Investigation/Discovery

In college, you must use credible sources to write a good paper. We no longer need to rely solely on primary sources for content. We ought to ask, "What is happening?" rather than "What happened?" Do those character(s)/plots suggest anything about them? While reading, take notes on your ideas and thoughts.

An [essay writer](#) may need to gather secondary sources once he or she has finished actively reading the primary source. Remember that you don't need to read all the books that may come up in your

research. Alternatively, you can either search the index for the terms you will discuss in your paper or look for a title that you feel will contain relevant information. Most often, you will use online journals peer-reviewed by experts. Remember to use other search engines, such as Google Scholar, as well as the online search through the Knight-Capron Library.

Write-Up

During the prewriting process, tools such as freewriting, brainstorming, outlining, and clustering is used. There are no off-topic or strange ideas in prewriting. You can figure out what you want to write about by going through these ideas. Most people believe that if you do not think outside the box, you will not be contributing anything new to the topic. During prewriting, the writer needs to decide who their audience is. You might ask: "Who is going to read my paper?", "what is this paper about?". Setting your audience with "will this be helpful". This simple response is "My professor" and "because they assigned it." And that's not the real answer. If you're writing for elementary school students or seminar participants or conference attendees, your paper could be geared towards this audience. Both audiences would speak differently and have a very different tone.

Drafting

Writing a paper begins with drafting. Drafting your paper should already be guided by a thesis idea. You cannot frame your writing after the fact if you don't have a thesis. When the writer drafts, he or she should make use of the materials gathered during the prewriting phase, as well as notes captured during discovery and investigation. Rather than start with an introduction, many writers approach their body paragraphs first (especially if they're not sure of where their paper is going).

When you begin with body paragraphs, you can let your ideas flow freely without feeling constrained by a particular thesis but be ready to delete paragraphs that are not needed. Then, write a conclusion (with a revised thesis statement) reflecting the body of your essay. Sometimes it can be difficult to write a paper and, in such cases, you can always hire a [paper writing service](#) to assist you in your task. A revision can be global or local in scope. In evaluating a paper globally, you should consider factors such as its cohesion and its overall progression. There is a lack of cohesion if you have paragraphs that don't flow into each other but change topics abruptly before returning to a previous point later. When you change topics from paragraph to paragraph, you will either have to revise your writing, adding new paragraphs, or changing the order of your paragraphs to explain the changes. There is a substantial

improvement in readability and comprehension of a paper that includes smooth transitions. The best way to arrange your paragraphs so that your argument builds instead of stacking them up to equal in weight is to group all like thoughts. A paper's blueprint is in its thesis statement, the most important argument of your paper. However, the thesis statement should not be its conclusion. You can use the early paragraphs to build your conclusions by using them as examples.

For local issues, you need to ensure your ideas are coherent and clear in your sentences. Using a variety of sentence structures and avoiding repetitive expressions is one of the best ways to avoid and fix local issues. You may feel mechanical when you keep repeating the same sentence structure, resulting in an uninteresting topic looking boring. Reviewing

Reviewing what you have written in the last step before writing a paper is crucial. While reviewing your paper one last time, you should pay attention to any grammar, spelling, or punctuation errors introduced during the revision process or that were overlooked during the revision process itself.
