For in-depth research, the author should divide the research material into primary and secondary material. In most cases, researchers take data from secondary sources so that they can materialize their stances but actually this is counterproductive. Rather than a helping hand, this approach spoils the entire impression of the research paper.

In this regard, it is necessary to ensure a balance between primary and secondary data sources. Again this balance would result in improved credibility of the research paper. Primary sources should be used as a fundamental source for your primary stance in the research topic and hypothesis. In the following stages of the research paper, secondary sources to <u>Buy</u> <u>dissertation</u> might be included but again that balance between primary and secondary sources must be kept into consideration. For secondary research sources, reports and statistics of think tanks are often used. For in-depth research, reports coming from different organizations and think tanks cannot be accepted without a pinch of salt. Everything that is published cannot be assumed as the ultimate truth. Often these aspects are not catered to and resultantly the purpose of in-depth research is not attained.

For in-depth research, often quoted sources are not time-bound. Relevant material does not mean that it would meet the requirement of the research paper if too much time has lapsed since its publication. In the case of social sciences, perspective and statistics can become entirely irrelevant in a short span of time. Hence, for in-depth research, times of publication should also be considered. This time-bound/ time-restricted research is no longer an issue because, in almost all online data sources, such filters are provided. The researcher can use those filters according to the need of the research paper.

For in-depth research, a diverse approach is desirable but that diversity should not be based on unauthentic sources. Before delving into the details of the research paper, journals should be specified. For instance, if the author has an interest in any research topic of biotechnology, then he/she should be aware of credible and renowned sources. If the researcher has issues in sorting out these aspects, then he/she has two plausible options. Either supervisor or seniors can be consulted or service of relevant **paper writing service** like <u>sharkpapers.com</u> can also be attained. Lack of credible sources in the literature review or the essay writing would be manifested in the final paper. The shallowness of the research would be reflected in shallow writing outcomes and vice versa.
