



What is the somatropin used for?

Where do you inject somatropin?

This medicine is given as a shot **under your skin or into a muscle**. Somatropin may sometimes be given at home to patients who do not need to be in the hospital. If you are using this medicine at home, your doctor will teach you how to prepare and inject the medicine.

What are the negative side effects of HGH?

HGH treatment might cause a number of side effects for healthy adults, including:

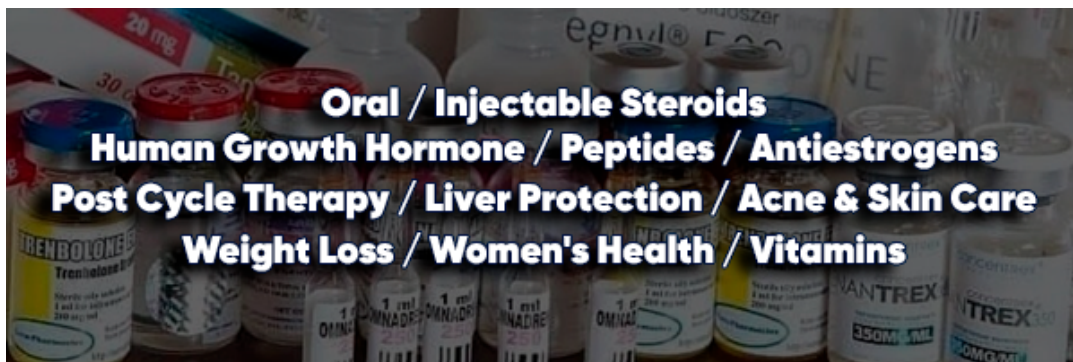
- Carpal tunnel syndrome.
- Increased insulin resistance.
- Type 2 diabetes.
- Swelling in the arms and legs (edema)
- Joint and muscle pain.
- For men, enlargement of breast tissue (gynecomastia)
- Increased risk of certain cancers.

Is somatropin safe?

Somatropin may contain an ingredient that can cause serious side effects or death in very young or premature babies. **Do not give this medicine to a child without medical advice.**

Is Human Growth Hormone good for you?

It's important for **growth, cell regeneration, and cell reproduction**. HGH helps to maintain, build, and repair healthy tissue in the brain and other organs. This hormone can help to speed up healing after an injury and repair muscle tissue after exercise. This helps to build muscle mass, boost metabolism, and burn fat.

How much does somatropin cost?

The cost for Genotropin subcutaneous powder for injection 0.2 mg is **around \$225** for a supply of 7 powder for injection, depending on the pharmacy you visit.

What can I monitor with somatropin?

Assessment

- Monitor blood glucose periodically during therapy. Diabetic patients may require ↑ insulin dose.
- Monitor for development of neutralizing antibodies if growth rate does not exceed 2.5 cm/6 mo.
- Monitor alkaline phosphatase closely in patients with adult growth hormone deficiency.

Does HGH shorten your life?

Other research has shown that people with low levels of HGH due to surgical or radiation damage to the pituitary gland that makes HGH have **increased risk of cardiovascular disease**, a factor that can shorten life span.

Does HGH make nose bigger?

' **And the answer is, once you're an adult**, growth hormone will give you a big nose, but it won't make you any taller. " Nose and ears, which are made of cartilage, continue to grow throughout a person's life, although in most people this is hardly noticeable.

Does HGH damage your liver?

HGH prompts the liver and other organs to make IGF-1, which affects many tissues and organs in the body. Studies usually measure IGF-1 rather than growth hormone directly because IGF-1 levels remain more constant.

How is somatropin given?

Somatropin is **injected into a muscle or under the skin**. A healthcare provider can teach you how to properly use the medication by yourself. Read and carefully follow any Instructions for Use provided with your medicine.

How do you take somatropin?

1. Weight Based Regimen:
2. 0.1 mg/kg subcutaneously once a day at bedtime.
3. Approximately 0.1 mg/kg subcutaneously once a day.
4. Pediatric Growth Hormone Deficiency (GHD):
5. Up to 0.067 mg/kg subcutaneously once a day.
6. Up to 0.053 mg/kg subcutaneously once a day.

Does HGH make your head bigger?

And HGH can indeed affect the size of your noggin. The hormone, which is produced by the pituitary gland, normally stimulates bone and tissue growth throughout the body. In an adult, **very large doses of HGH can cause the skull to thicken and the forehead and eyebrow ridge to become especially prominent.**

What age is best for growth hormone treatment?

GH injections are quick and almost pain-free, so children **ages 10 and up** may be able to and often prefer to give themselves their own injections. It is important that a parent supervises the injection to make sure the child gives the correct dosage each day. Parents should give the injections to younger children.

What's the truth about SeroVital?

SeroVital is marketed as an **anti-aging remedy** that works by raising human growth hormone (HGH) levels naturally with amino acids. The research consists of one preliminary study that measured HGH levels. There is no clinical evidence that it is effective for anything.
